- <u>Information Passively Collected from You</u>. We may collect Personal Data passively via cookies, pixels, and other tracking technologies when you visit our Site or otherwise use our Services. We may collect the following categories of Personal Data in this manner:
  - o Identifiers, such as internet protocol (IP) address, mobile advertising ID, or media access control (MAC) address
  - o Geolocation data, such as the approximate location of your device, as revealed by your device's IP address
  - Internet, browser, and other network information, such as your browser type, browser version, information about your interaction with our Site, including the pages that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, and the content and advertisements you have accessed or seen, and similar information

o Inferences drawn from any of the information listed above to understand more about your preferences and interests

### **Cookies and Tracking Technologies**

Cookies. A "cookie" is a small text file that is placed on your device when you visit a website. When the operator of the website places the cookie on your device, it is referred to as a "first-party cookie."
